SEXUAL ABUSE OF A MINOR OR VULNERABLE ADULT - DIOCESAN PROTOCOL

A few decades ago, like many Quebec and Canadian dioceses, the Archdiocese of Gatineau gave itself several tools to properly manage any allegation of sexual abuse committed by one of its priests. Among these tools were a clear and detailed protocol, a committed advisory committee, and a competent episcopal delegate able to respond to these allegations.

Even if such allegations are becoming increasingly rare, Archbishop Durocher is proceeding these days with the updating of the protocol and the renewal of the advisory committee and its mandate, in accordance with the most recent developments in Church law in this area. He is pleased to appoint a woman as a delegate to manage such allegations, Ms. Lise Duguay of Notre-Dame-de-l'Eau-Vive parish. (This post had always been held by a priest.)

Also, he appoints Mr. Daniel Dezainde, president of a new committee that will work on the prevention of sexual abuse of minors and vulnerable people in our parish environments.

On our <u>website</u>, you will find <u>Archbishop Durocher's decree</u> announcing these changes, the <u>renewed protocol</u> for the management of allegations, <u>an abridged version</u> of this protocol, and an <u>illustration of the decision tree</u> established by the protocol.

These initiatives manifest the constant concern of the Archdiocese of Gatineau to protect its young members and respond quickly and responsibly to any victim of clerical sexual abuse. Let us pray that these initiatives will bear fruit and that never again will a child or young person be hurt in our Church.




MONTH OF MARY

EXEMPTION FROM THE DIOCESAN CONTRIBUTION DUE TO THE PANDEMIC

During its regular meeting on April 19, the Diocesan Council for Economic Affairs decided to grant parishes an exemption of 1/50 of their 2021 diocesan contributions for each Sunday of the period from January 10 to February 21, 2021. The credit for the seven Sundays when the churches had been closed at the request of the government for sanitary measures will be granted with the invoice of the diocesan contribution for the second quarter of 2021. If parishes have decided to extend the closure of their church after February 21, the exemption does not apply for additional Sundays. Parishes that have questions or particular difficulties for their finances are invited to contact the diocese to discuss them. This is the second time in a year that the diocese has granted such exemption due to the health crisis. The objective is to help each parish face the decrease in revenue from regular collections. Thank you!
